
## 3-TERMINAL 300mA POSITIVE VOLTAGE REGULATOR

- \* Short Circuit Current Limiting











Fig.1 Ambient Temperature vs. Power Dissipation




Fig.2 78N05 Output Voltage vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig.3 78N08 Output Volatge vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig.4 Output Characteristics ( $I_{OUT}=0mA, T_J=25^{\circ}C$ )




Fig.5 78N05 Dropout Characteristics ( $T_J=25^{\circ}C$ )





Fig.6 Short Circuit Output Current ( $T_J=25^{\circ}C$ )



Fig.7 78N05 Quiescent Current vs. Input Voltage ( $I_{OUT}=0\text{mA}$ ,  $T_J=25^\circ\text{C}$ )
