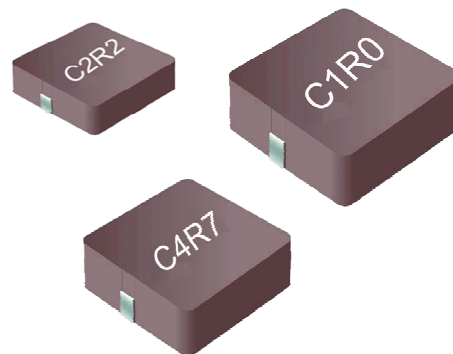


## SMD Molding Power Inductor

- 6、RoHS compliant.



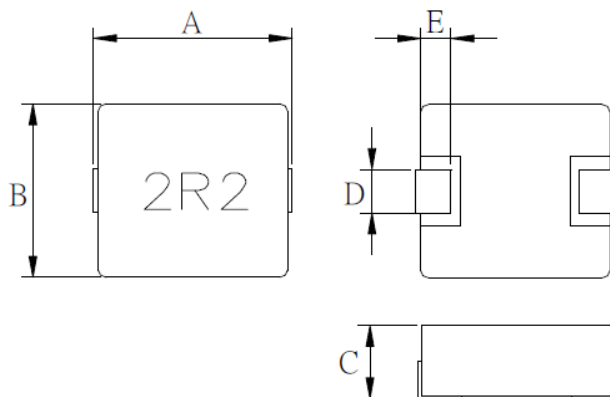




### NOTES:

1. DC current (Idc) that will cause an approximate  $\Delta T$  of 40°C
2. DC current (Isat) that will cause Lo to drop approximately 20%
3. All test data is referenced to 25°C ambient
4. Operating Temperature Range -55°C to +150°C
5. The part temperature (ambient + temp rise) should not exceed 150°C under the worst operating conditions. Circuit design, component placement, PWB trace size and thickness, airflow and other cooling provisions all affect the part temperature. Part temperature should be verified in the end application.

## ◆ Recommended Soldering Technologies

### (1) Re-flowing Profile

Preheat condition: 150 ~200°C/60~180sec.

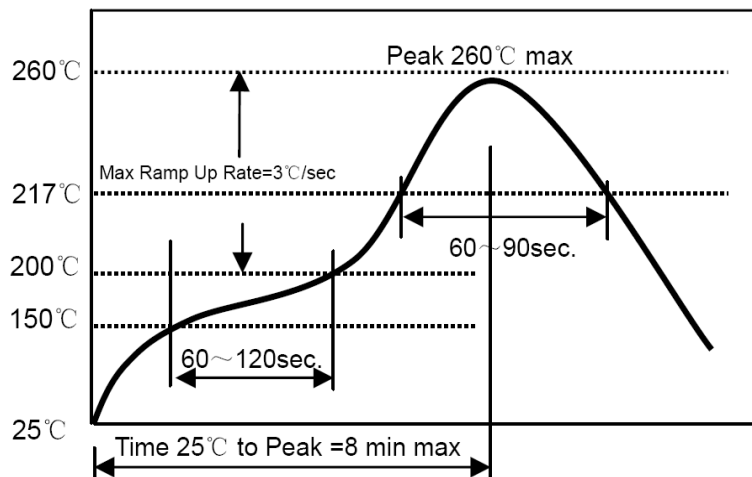
Allowed time above 217°C: 80~120sec.

Max temp: 260°C

Max time at max temp: 10 sec.

Solder paste: Sn/3.0Ag/0.5Cu

Allowed Reflow time: 2x max



### (2) Iron Soldering Profile

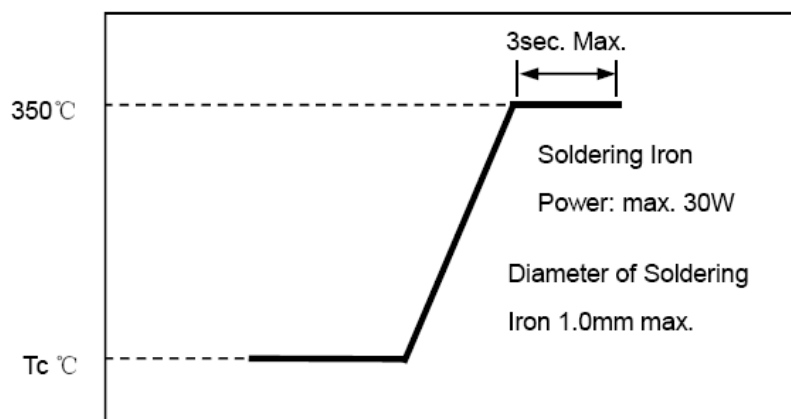
Iron soldering power: Max. 30W

Soldering time: 3sec. Max.

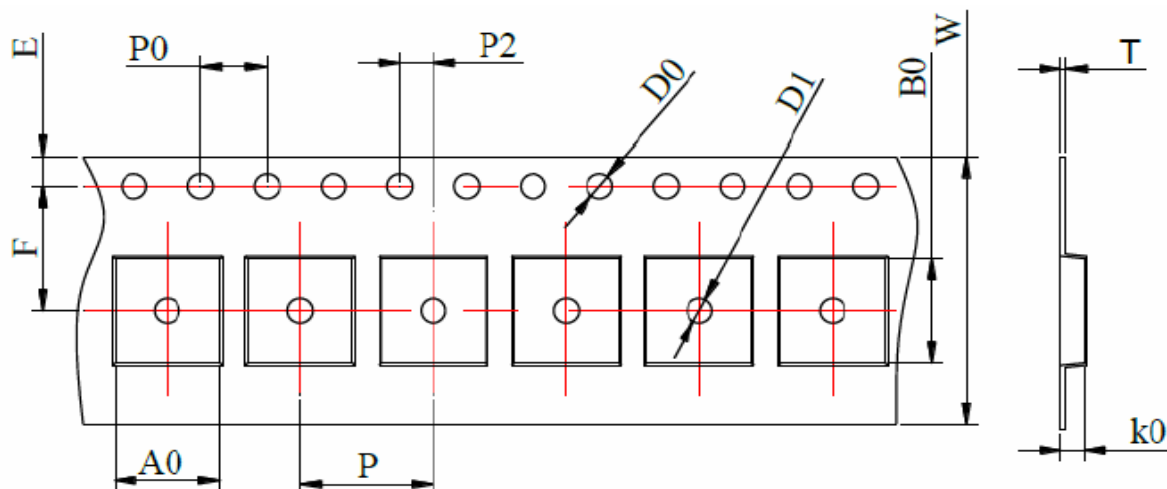
Solder paste: Sn/3.0Ag/0.5Cu

Max.1 times for iron soldering



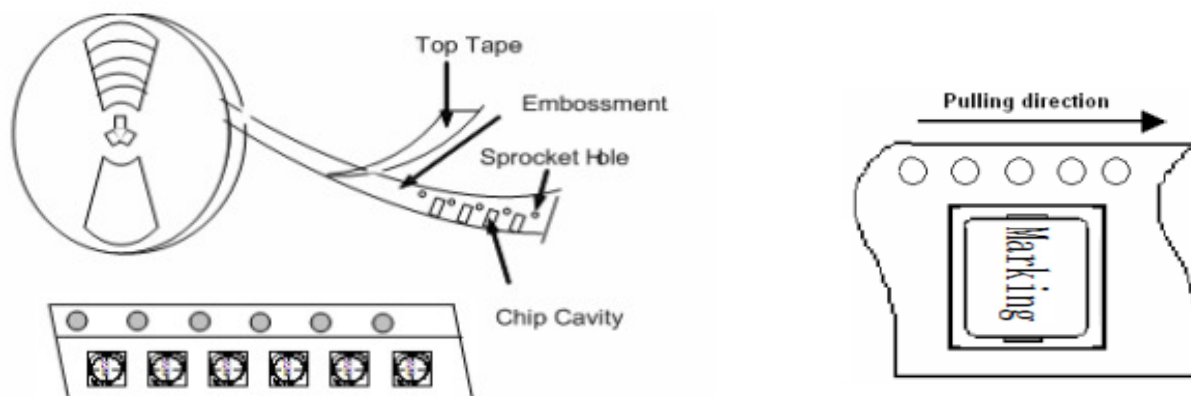

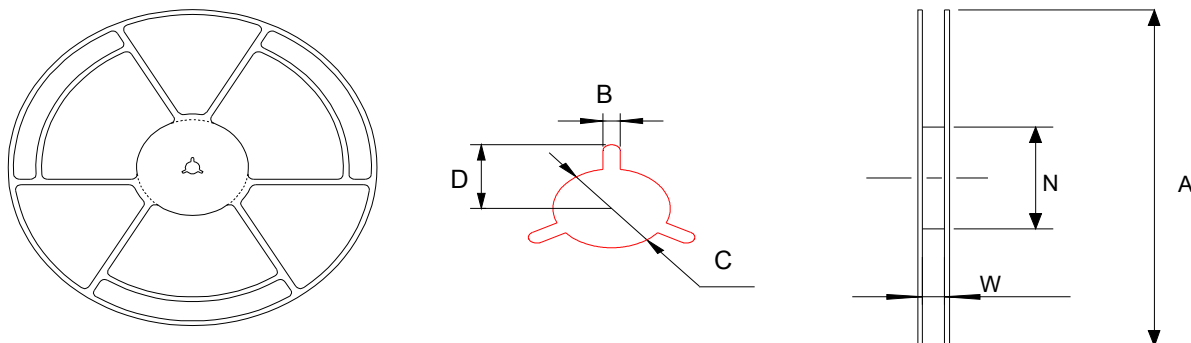
