


Figure 1. DC current Gain




Figure 2. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage




Figure 3. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage




Figure 4. Safe Operating Area





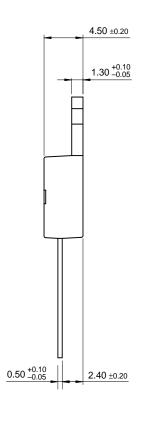
Figure 5. Power Derating
