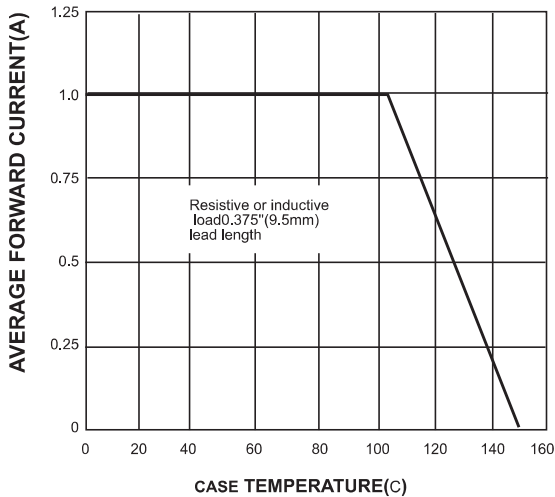

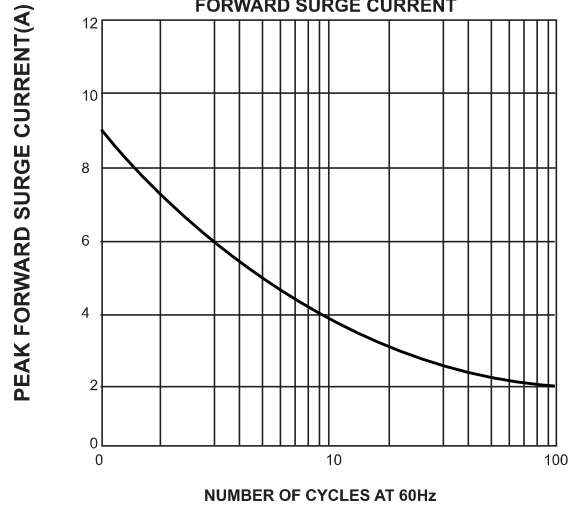

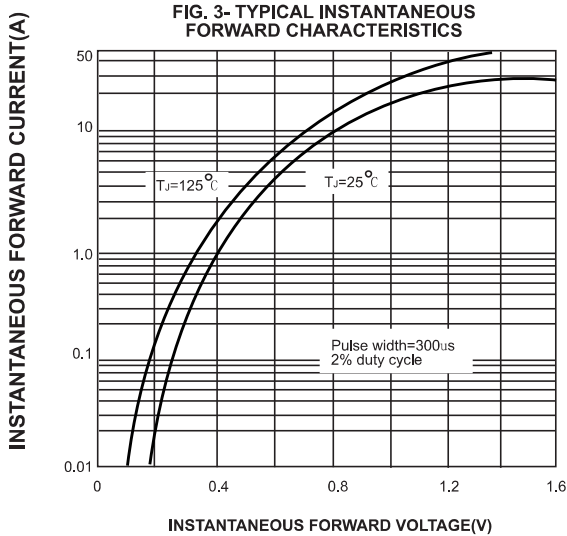
**FIG. 1- FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE**



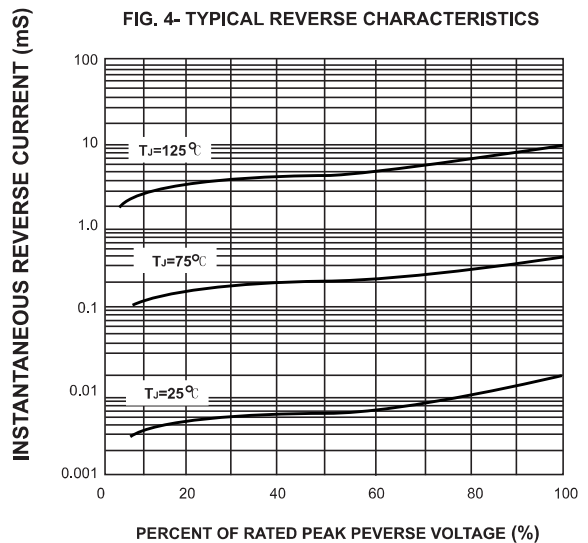
**FIG. 2-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT**



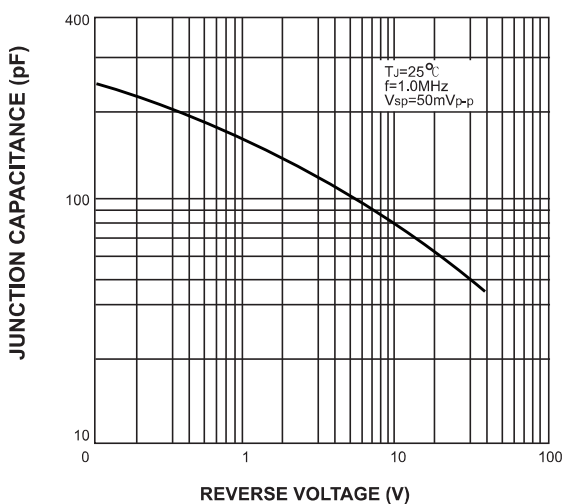
**FIG. 3- TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS**
