






Figure 3.On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

V<sub>GS</sub>, GATE-TO-SOURCE VOLTAGE (V)




Figure 5.On-Resistance Variation with **Temperature**




Figure 7.Capacitance Variation




Figure 8.Gate-to-Source Voltage vs. Total Charge




Figure 9.Resistive Switching Time Variation vs. Gate Resistance




Figure 10.Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current




Figure 11.Maximum Rated Forward Biased Safe Operating Area




Figure 12.Maximum Drain Current vs. Time in Avalanche


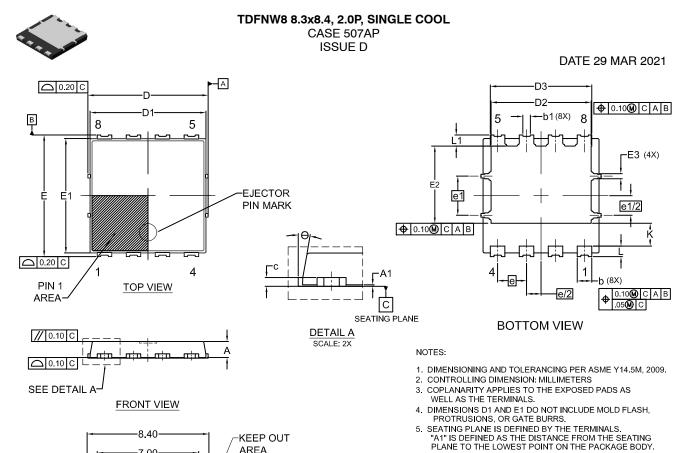


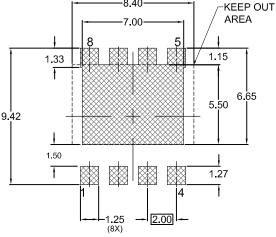
Figure 13. Transient Thermal Impedance

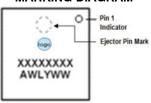
