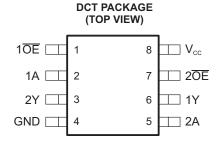
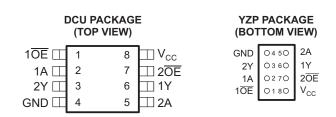

### DESCRIPTION/ORDERING INFORMATION

This dual bus buffer gate is operational at 0.8-V to 2.7-V V<sub>CC</sub>, but is designed specifically for 1.65-V to 1.95-V V<sub>CC</sub> operation.

The SN74AUC2G125 features dual line drivers with 3-state outputs. The outputs are disabled when the associated output-enable (OE) input is high.

NanoFree™ package technology is a major breakthrough in IC packaging concepts, using the die as the package.

To ensure the high-impedance state during power up or power down, OE should be tied to V<sub>CC</sub> through a pullup resistor; the minimum value of the resistor is determined by the current-sinking capability of the driver.

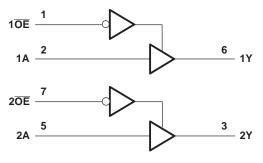

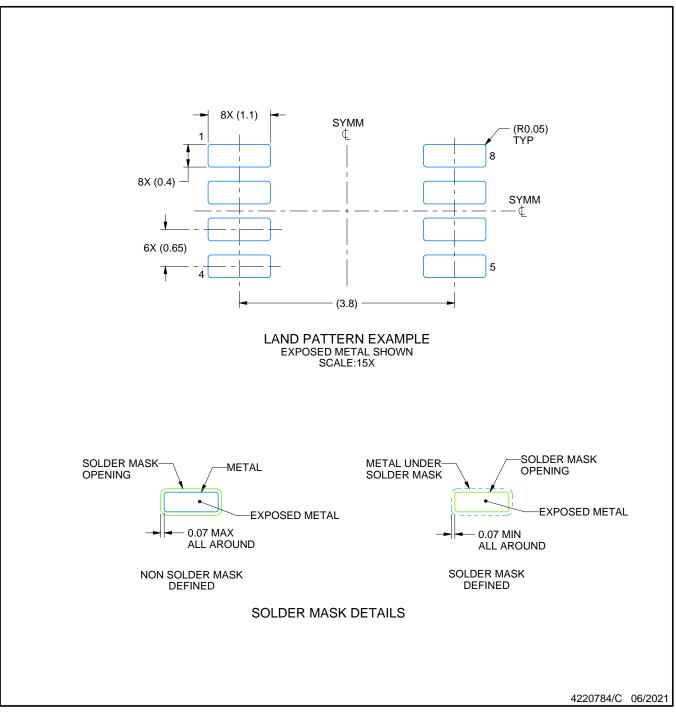

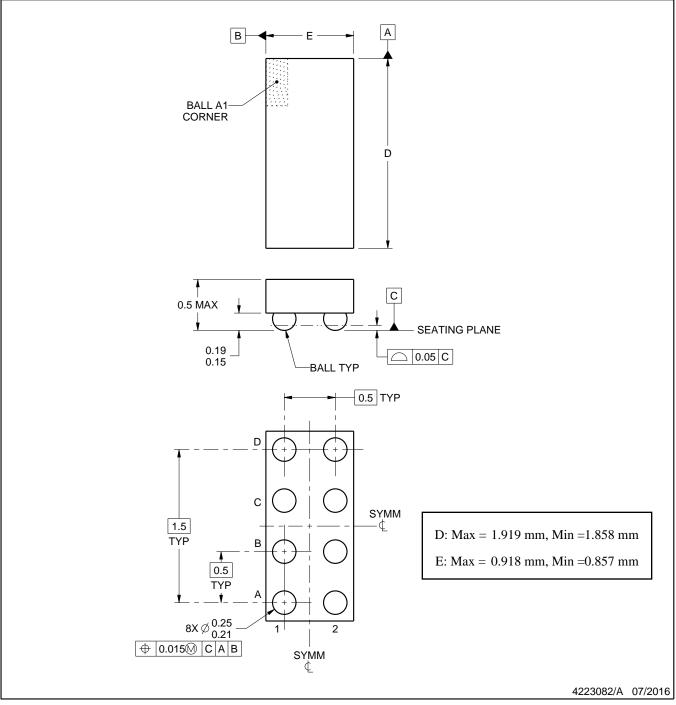
