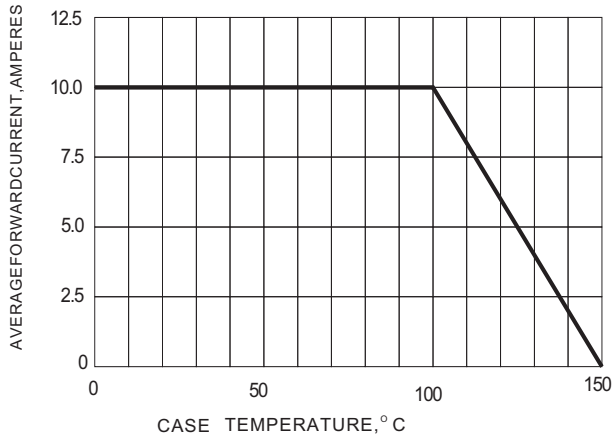


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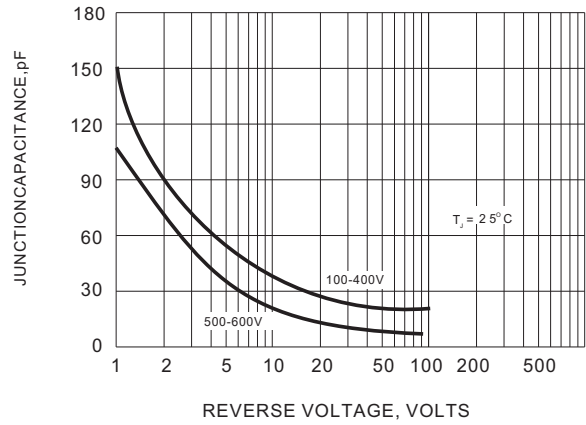

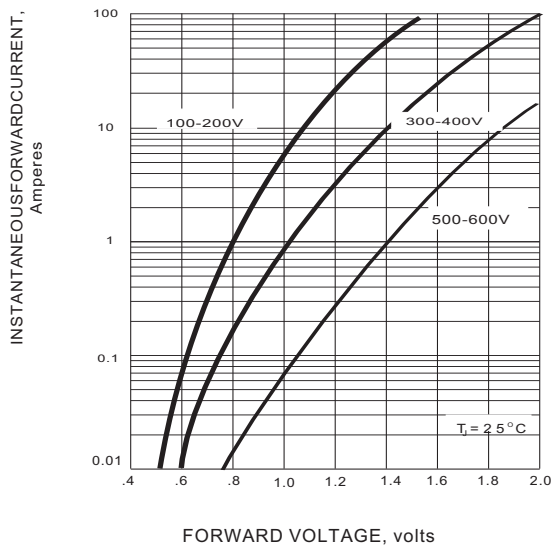
**Fig.1 FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE**



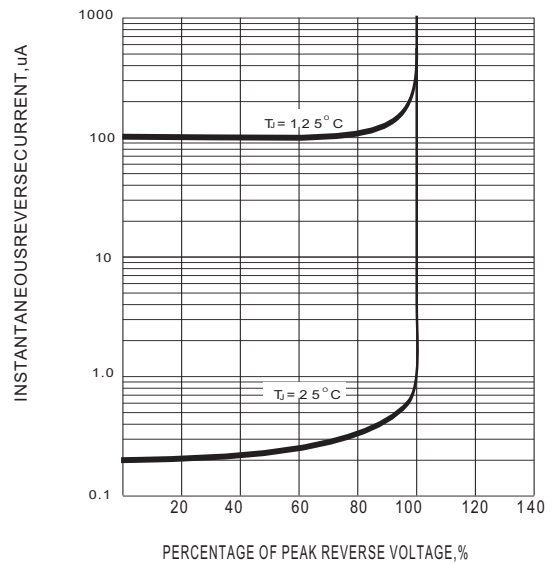
**Fig.2 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCES**



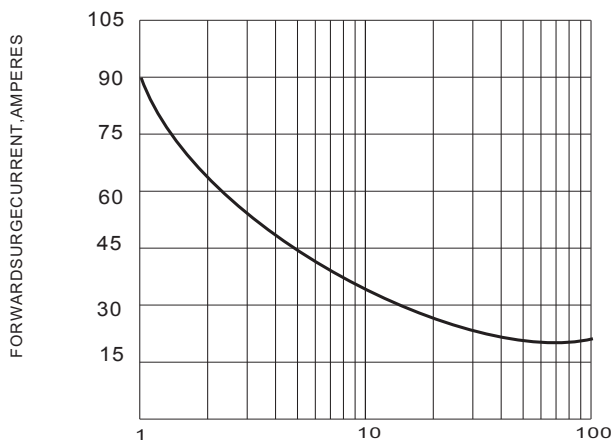
**Fig.3 FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS**
