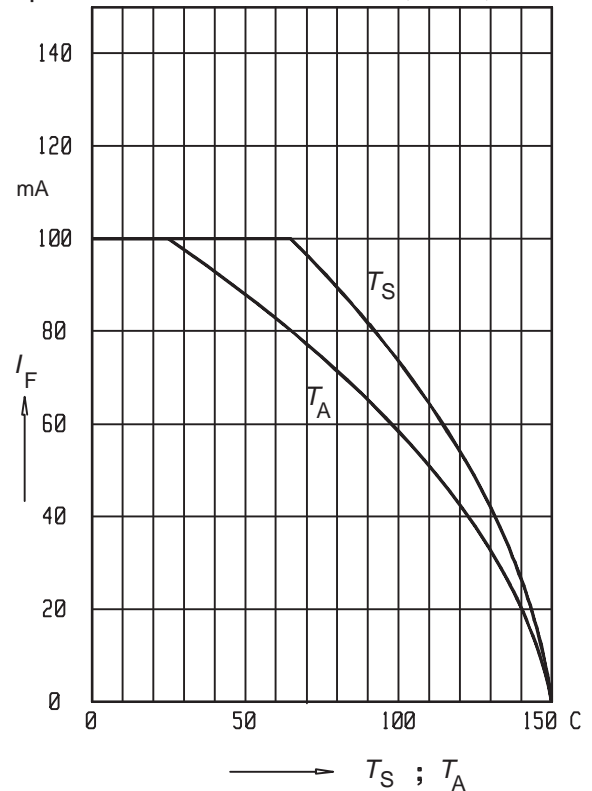
Forward current $r_F = f(T_S; T_A^*)$

per each diode BAR64-04W,-05W,-06W

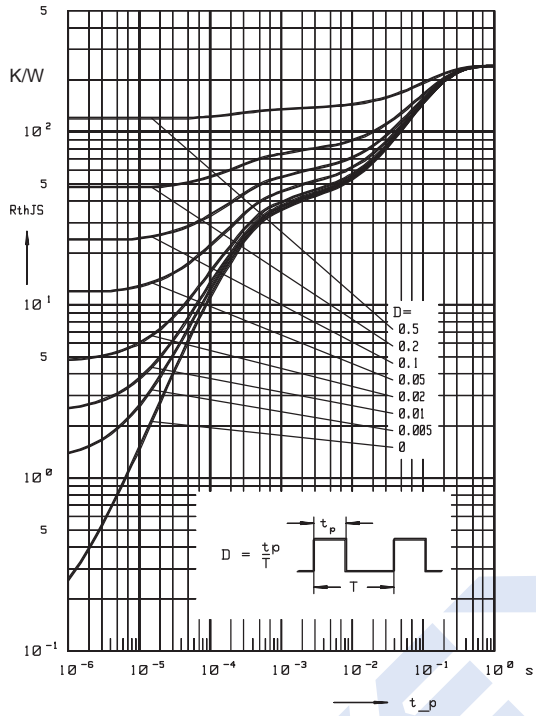

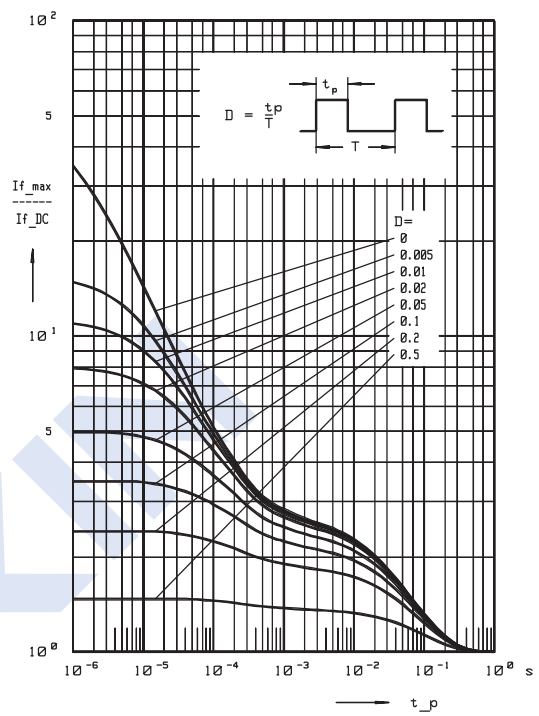

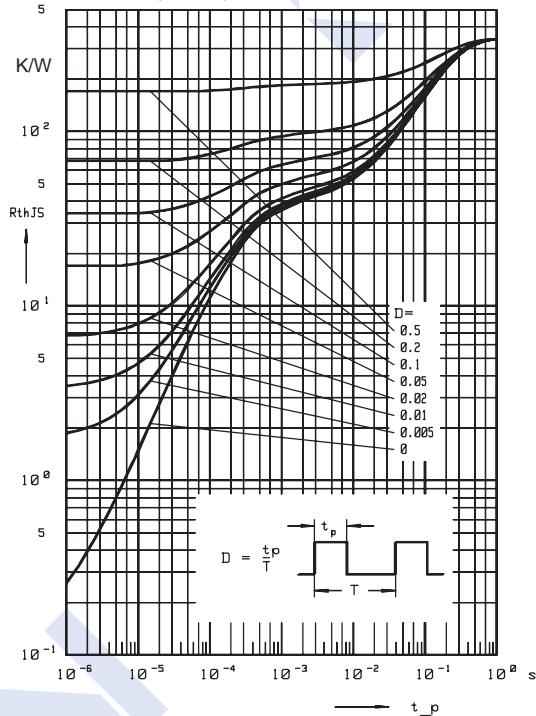
Permissible pulse load $R_{thJS} = f(t_p)$

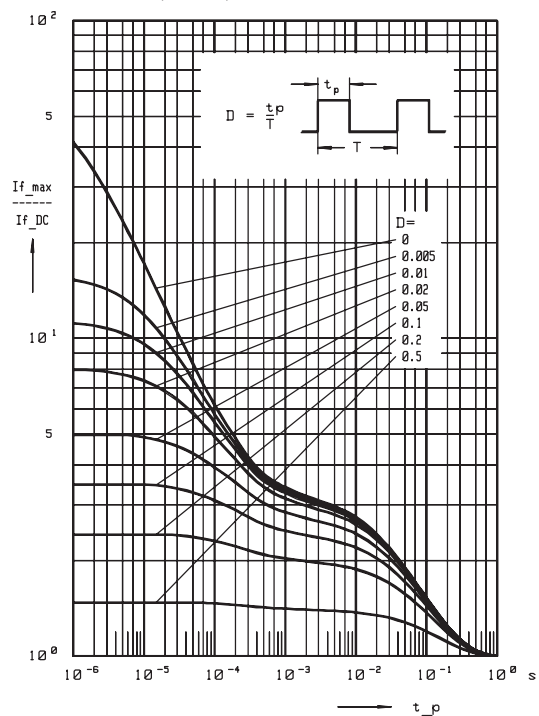
Permissible pulse load $I_{fmax}/I_{fDC} = f(t_p)$

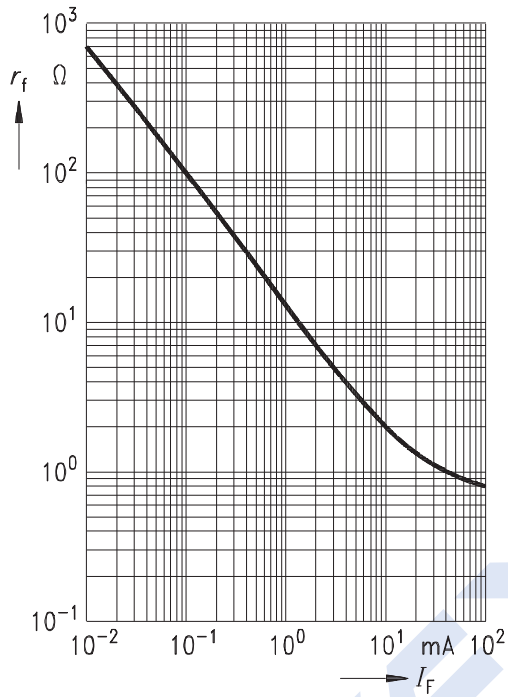

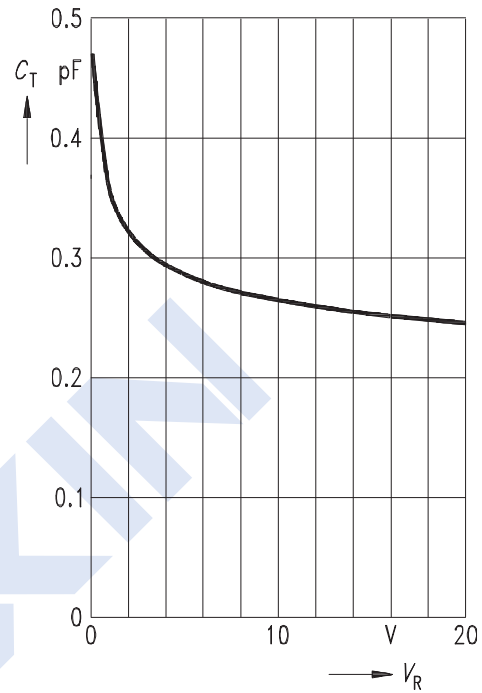
