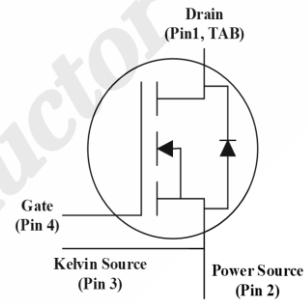

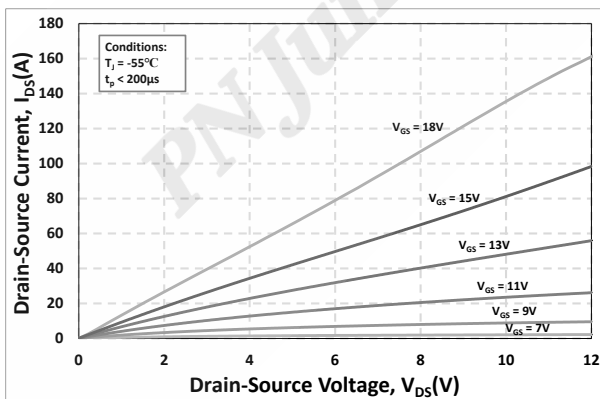


Figure 1. Output Characteristics  $T_J = -55^\circ C$

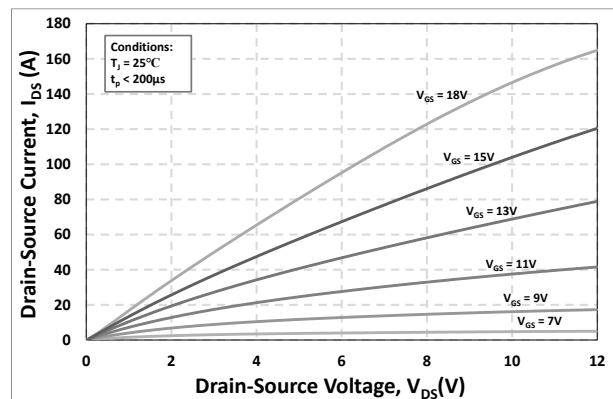


Figure 2. Output Characteristics  $T_J = 25^\circ C$

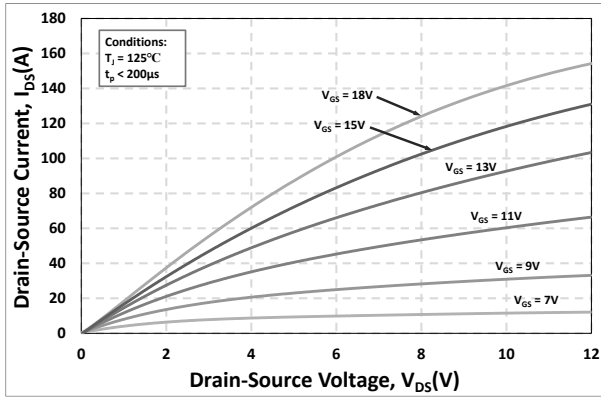


Figure 3. Output Characteristics  $T_J = 125^\circ\text{C}$

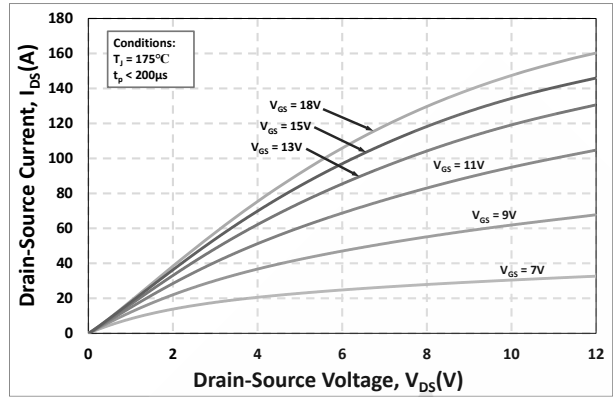


Figure 4. Output Characteristics  $T_J = 175^\circ\text{C}$

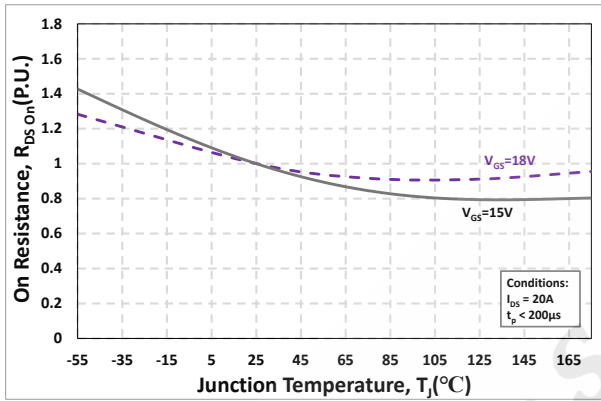


Figure 5. Normalized On-Resistance vs. Temperature

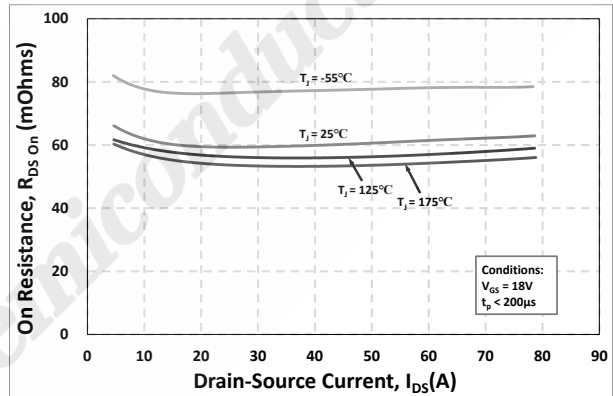


Figure 6. On-Resistance vs. Drain Current Various Temperatures

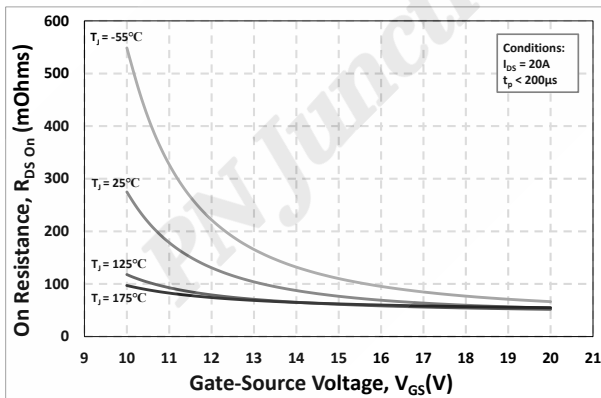


Figure 7. On-Resistance vs. Gate-Source Voltage

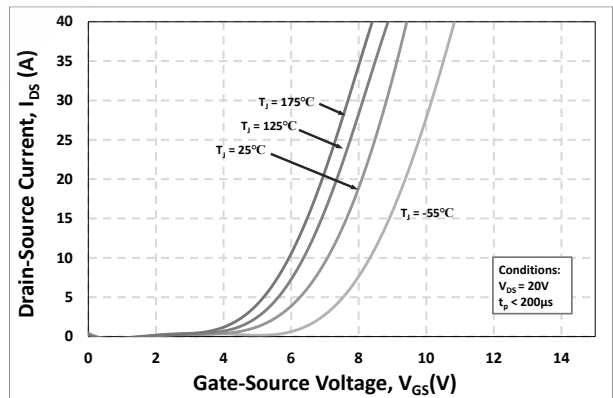


Figure 8. Transfer Characteristic for Various Junction Temperatures



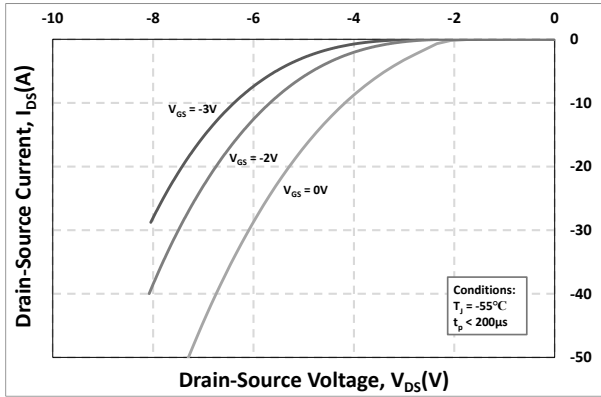


Figure 9. Body Diode Characteristic at -55°C

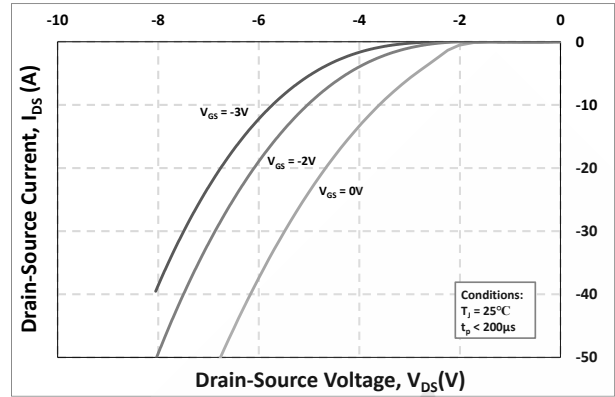


Figure 10. Body Diode Characteristic at 25°C

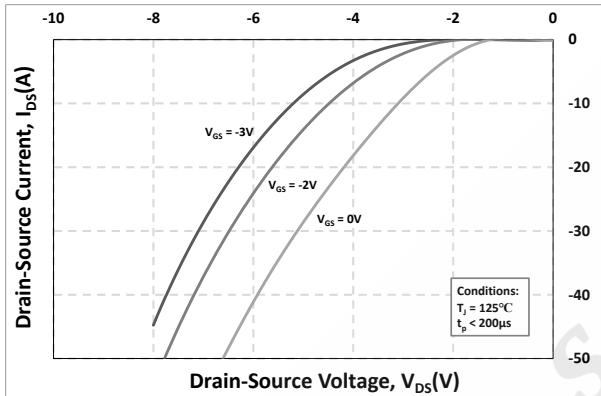


Figure 11. Body Diode Characteristic at 125°C

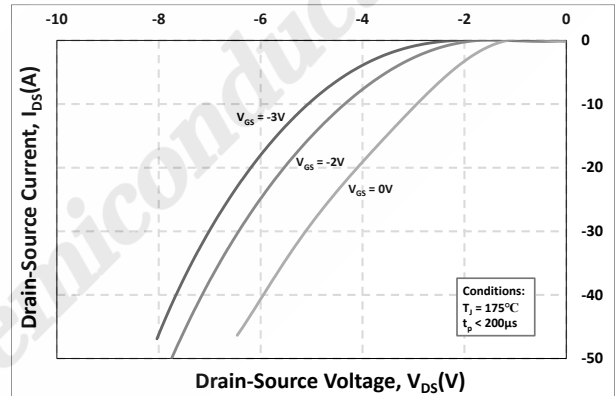


Figure 12. Body Diode Characteristic at 175°C

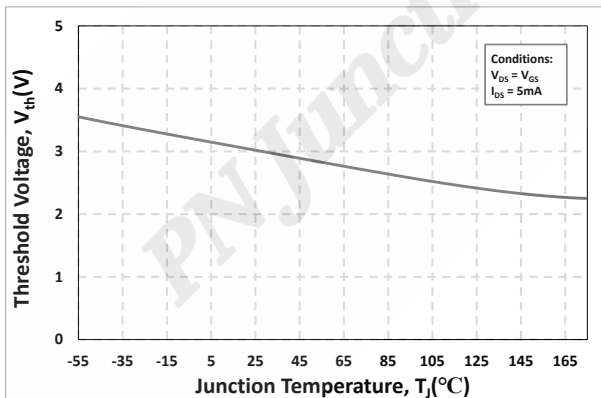


Figure 13. Threshold Voltage vs. Temperature

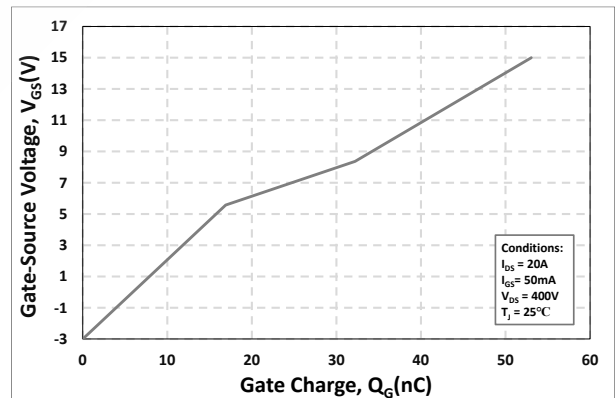


Figure 14. Gate Charge Characteristics

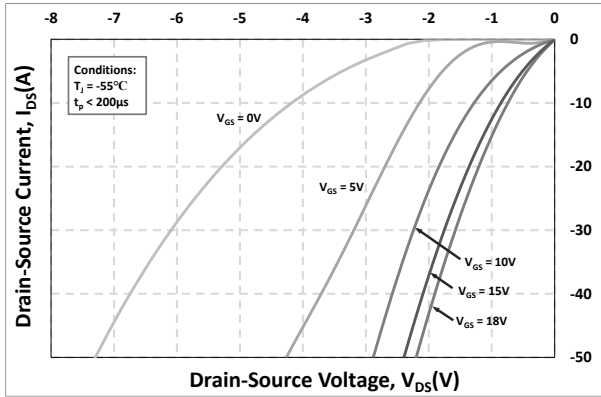


Figure 15. 3rd Quadrant Characteristic at -55°C

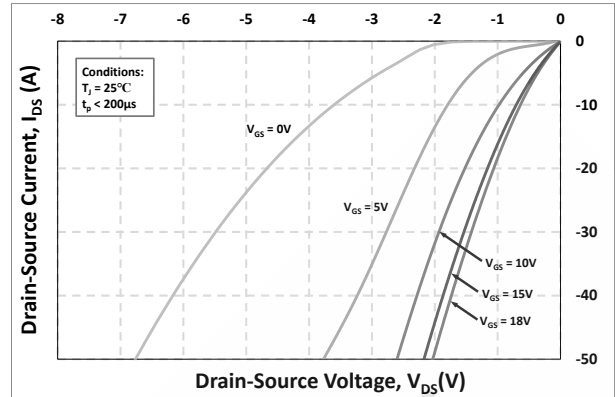


Figure 16. 3rd Quadrant Characteristic at 25°C

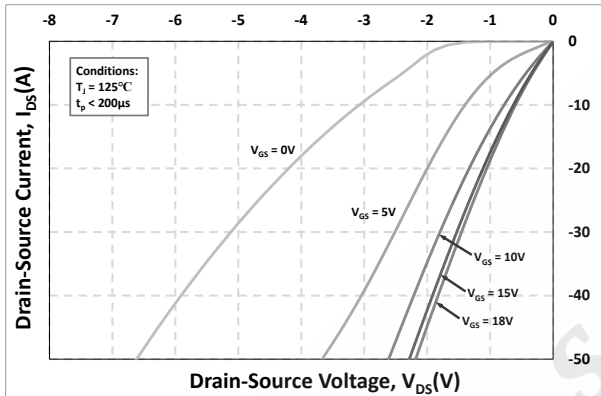


Figure 17. 3rd Quadrant Characteristic at 125°C

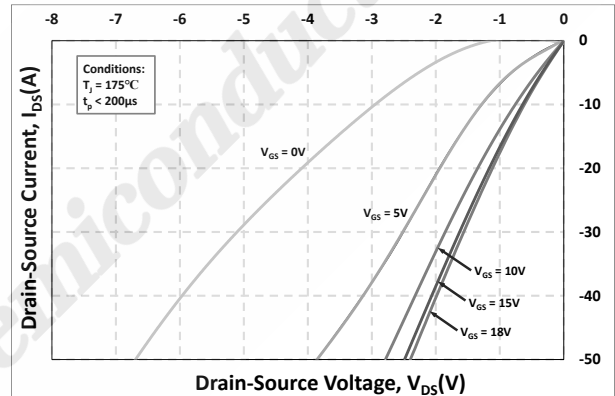


Figure 18. 3rd Quadrant Characteristic at 175°C

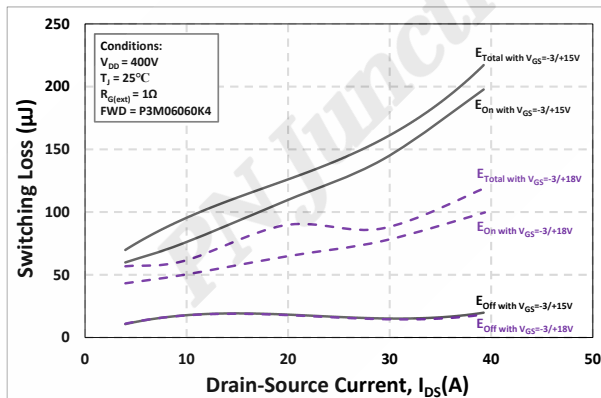


Figure 19. Clamped Inductive Switching Energy vs. Drain Current ( $V_{DD} = 400V$ )

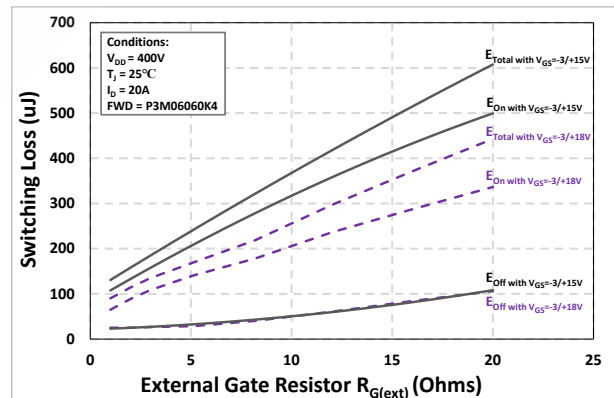


Figure 20. Clamped Inductive Switching Energy vs.  $R_{G(ext)}$

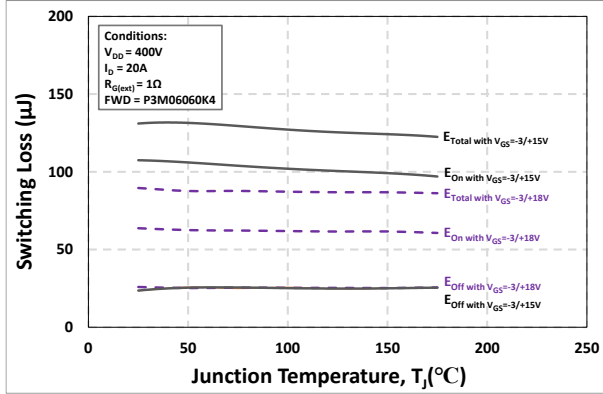


Figure 21. Clamped Inductive Switching Energy vs. Temperature

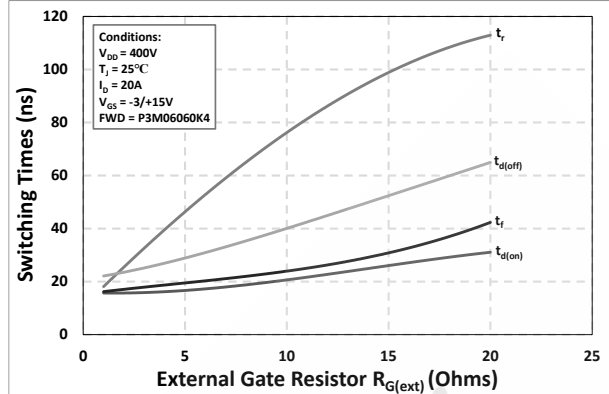


Figure 22. Switching Times vs.  $R_{G(ext)}$

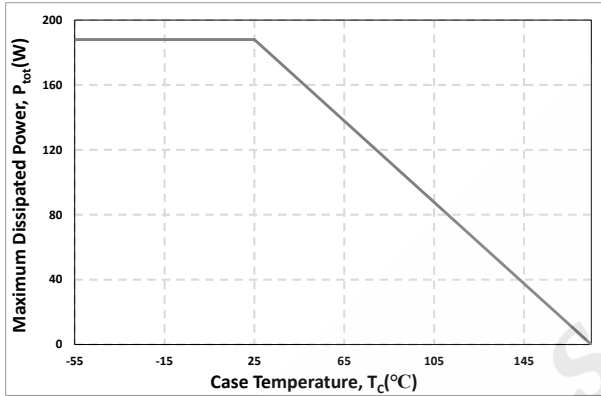


Figure 23. Maximum Power Dissipation Derating vs. Case Temperature

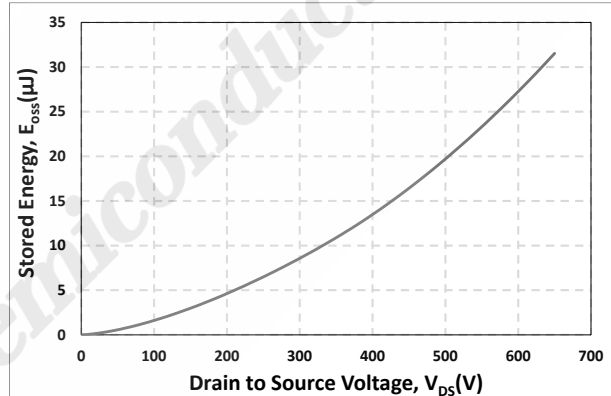


Figure 24. Output Capacitor Stored Energy

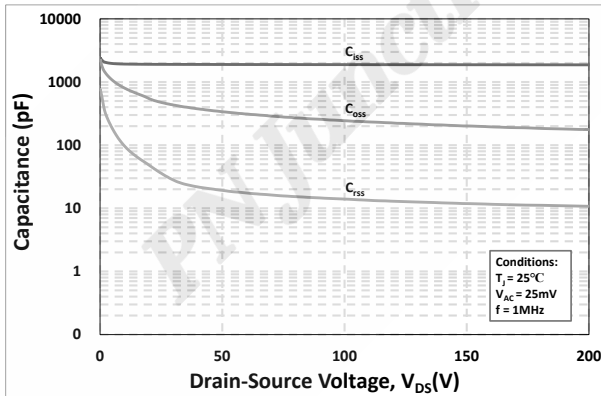


Figure 25. Capacitances vs. Drain-Source Voltage (0 - 200V)

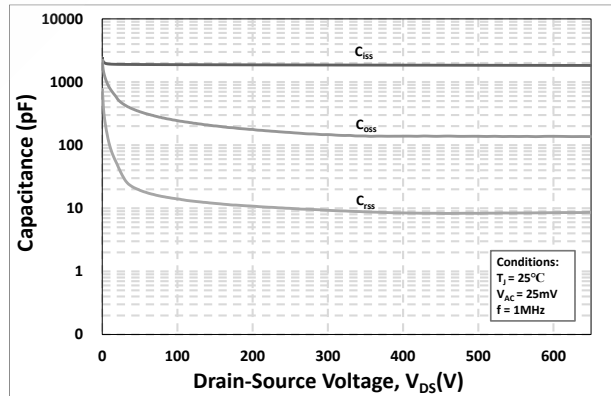


Figure 26. Capacitances vs. Drain-Source Voltage (0 - 650V)

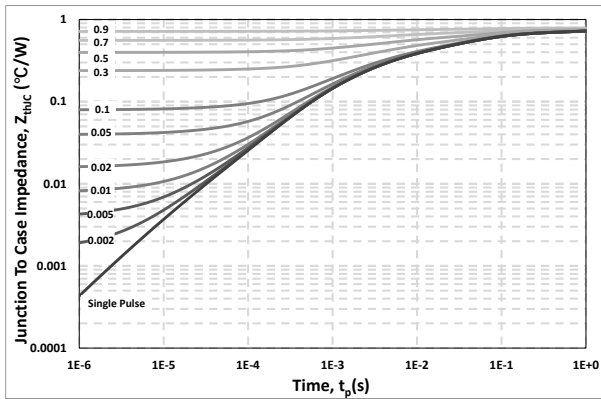


Figure 27. Transient Thermal Impedance (Junction - Case)

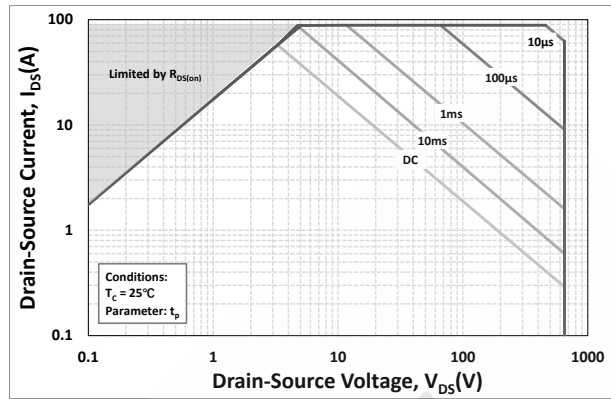


Figure 28. Safe Operating Area

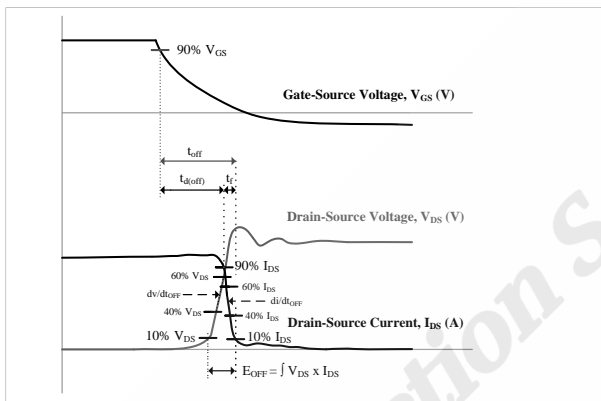


Figure 29. Turn-off Transient Definitions

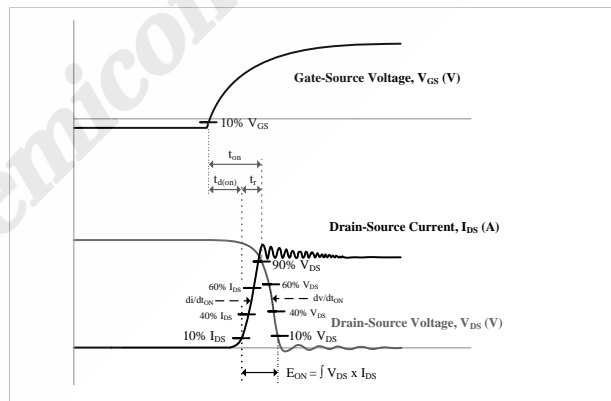


Figure 30. Turn-on Transient Definitions

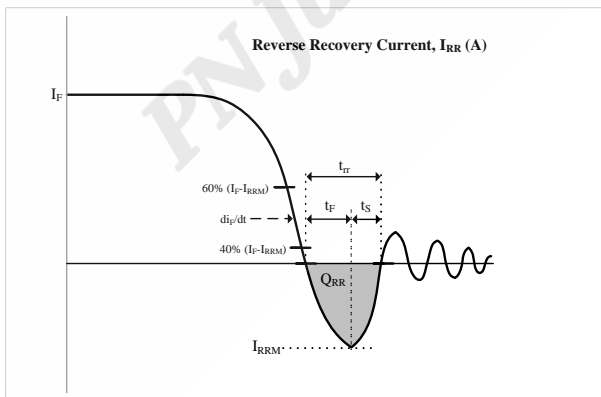


Figure 31. Reverse Recovery Definitions

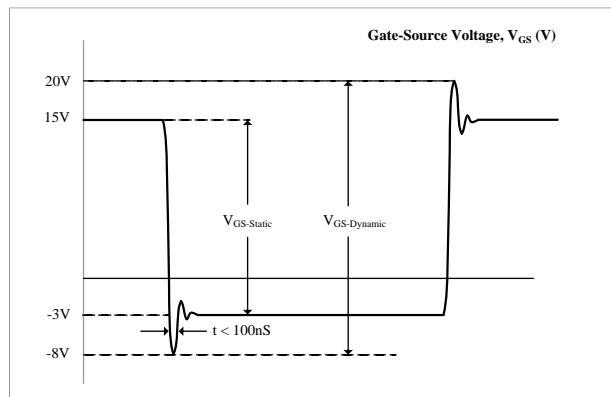
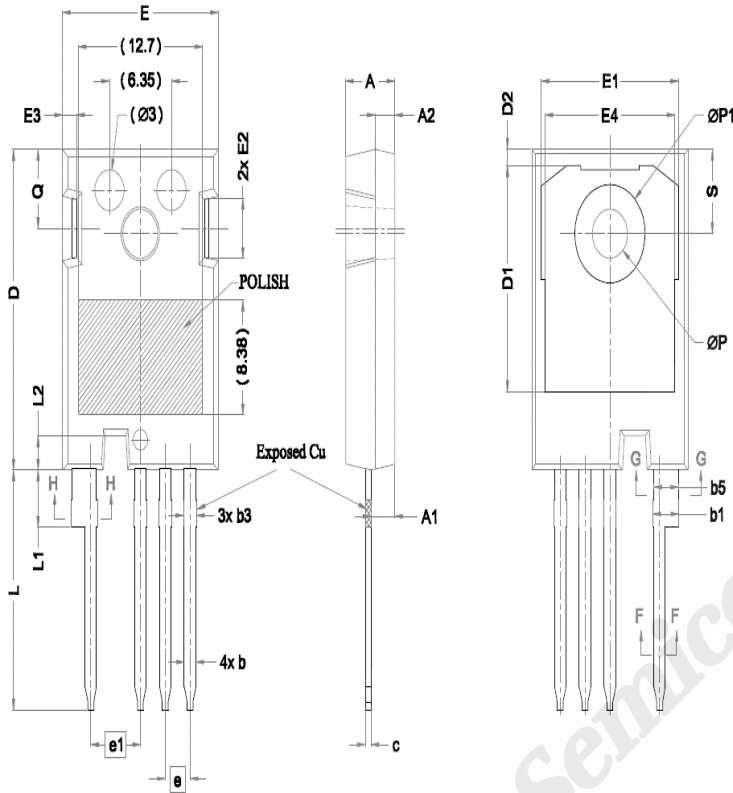


Figure 32. V<sub>GS</sub> Transient Definitions
